Identify common letter strings.</p> <p>Recognise word order conventions in sentences.</p> <p>Use the context and previous knowledge to work out meanings.</p> <p>Identify if a noun is masculine or feminine and plural.</p>	<p>Write a description of an imaginary monster.</p> <p>Use size and colour adjectives in the correct word order.</p>
